Breakfast Club & Dinner

The cost of breakfast club is £1.50. This is still the cheapest breakfast/childcare in the area. Children are provided with toast, scrambled egg, cereal, beans/spaghetti and juice

There are sports activities too on most days after school. Please look out for after school club letters at the beginning of the Autumn Term..

Due to strict health & Safety arrangements you will need to ensure that you book your child in on the Parent Pay site so that we know how many children to expect daily

NB
Dinners cost £2.30 per day. This is still less than many schools in the Doncaster area. It does need to be paid at the beginning of the week using the parent Pay system.

Once your child is registered as either dinner or packed lunch there can be no changes until the end of half term. This is so that cook can order the correct amount of food and reduce waste, and MDSA can be deployed.
