	<p>Design</p> <p>Design your dream garden? What would you include, a paddling pool, lots of flowers, a climbing frame? Be as creative as you like. Draw and label your ideas.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>Find items from around your home to make different instruments and sounds. Maybe you could use pots and pans, a straw, rice in a tube? Take a picture of your creations and don't forget to share them on class DoJo.</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p>Research the four countries of the United Kingdom. Find out different foods/flowers/saints etc that are particular to that country. Make a poster to show your findings.</p>
<p>Art</p> <p>Collect natural things from your garden or when you go on a walk Using twigs, leaves, grass, pebbles and other natural materials to make a picture or write your name.</p>	<p>Science/ Maths</p> <p>Go on a bug hunt in your garden or in the local park (making sure you socially distance). How many different insects/birds can you spot? Think of how you will record your results and observations. You could make a tally chart, a block diagram?</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Which is your favourite insect/animal that you can find locally? Use the internet to research information about your chosen insect/animal. Create a colourful fact-file to share your findings with others in our class. (This should include pictures and facts/information)</p>	<p>English</p> <p>Create a story for someone in Nursery or Reception that involves nature. It could be a story set in the countryside. It could involve talking insects (like Bugs Life, Superworm or even James and the Giant Peach) Make sure you include a beginning, middle and an end to the story.</p>
<p>Maths</p> <p>Look around the house for odd and even numbers of items. Maybe you could draw them or take a picture? e.g. I have 17 odd socks</p> <p>Remember even numbers can be shared equally into 2 groups and they end in 0,2,4,6 and 8. Odd numbers end in 1,3,5,7 and 9.</p>	<p>What is it?</p> <p>Here is an item and the camera has zoomed in really close.
