Design

Science

Make sure you include a beginning, middle and an end to the story.

Maths

Look around the house for odd and even numbers of items. Maybe you could draw them or take a picture? e.g. I have 17 odd socks



Remember even numbers can be shared equally into 2 groups and they end in 0,2,4,6 and 8. Odd numbers end in 1,3,5,7 and 9.

What is it?

Here is an item and the camera has zoomed in really close. Can you guess what it is?
