P.E Sessions are on Mondays and Tuesdays

Please ensure that your child brings their P.E kit in their bags on a Monday morning. These can be kept in school during the week and brought home on Fridays. A plain white t-shirt, black shorts and trainers are required to participate in all PE/Sport activities. As the days get colder, black jogging bottoms/leggings and a jumper/jacket should be included, where possible.

Homework

Homework is usually set on a Friday to be handed in on Friday. The homework will usually consist of 8-10 spellings, a reading challenge and an extra Maths or English task.

Reading Diaries

Please listen to your child read regularly and sign their reading record card. Reading books and cards need to be brought to school each day. We expect our children to read at least 4 times per week! In Elder, we pride ourselves on being the best reading class in school and we need to continue with that!

How you can support your child's learning at home:

- Spend time reading/sharing a book with your child.
- Read your child's school reading book with them daily and comment on their reading card.
- Use the local library to encourage reading and support topic work.
- Practise times tables given by the teacher
- Use everyday opportunities to reinforce problem solving in their head.
- Try not to impose teaching methods you experienced at school ask the children to explain their methods to you.
- Practise spellings given by the teacher
- Encourage your child to talk about their learning
- Ensure that they have a quiet and suitable space for the completion of their homework.
- Encourage them to collect together the things they need for school, including their homework the night before it is due in. This will help to develop their independence.
