P.E Sessions are on Mondays

Please ensure that your child brings their P.E kit in their bags on a Monday morning. These can be kept in school during the week and brought home on Fridays. A plain white t-shirt, black shorts and trainers are required to participate in all PE/Sport activities. As the days get colder, black jogging bottoms/leggings and a jumper/jacket should be included, where possible. Please make sure all clothing items are clearly labelled.

Homework

Homework is increasingly important in Key Stage 1 and is usually set once a week. Spellings will also be sent home on a Friday for your child to practise. Homework will be set on a Friday and should be returned by the following Wednesday.

Reading Record Cards

Please listen to your child read daily if possible and sign their reading card. Reading books and cards need to be brought to school daily and will be changed every Friday.

How you can support your child's learning at home:

- Spend time reading/sharing a book with your child.
- Read your child's school reading book with them daily and comment in their reading diary.
- Use the local library to encourage reading and support topic work.
- Practise times tables given by the teacher (x2, x5, x10, x3)
- Use everyday opportunities to reinforce problem solving in their head.
- Ask the children to explain their methods to you, such as from Maths
- Practise spellings given by the teacher
- Encourage your child to talk about their learning
- Ensure that they have a quiet and suitable space for the completion of their homework.
- Encourage them to collect together the things they need for school, including their homework. This will help to develop their independence.


